

BANNER NEIGHBORHOODS BOARD MEMBER

Job Description

Established in 1982, Banner Neighborhoods is a community nonprofit organization that provides youth programming and senior home maintenance services to enhance the stability and quality of life in East Baltimore neighborhoods.

This is a volunteer position.

A Board member has the following duties:

- Attend 4 quarterly board meetings (January, April, July, October) and any necessary trainings or ad hoc meetings
- Commit to personally securing at least \$1,000 in funding for Banner annually
- Review and approve Banner's annual budget
- Assist with annual evaluation of Banner's Executive Director
- Engage in committee work (Governance, Fundraising, or Executive Committee)
- Be available to attend and/or help organize regular fundraising events
- Have a willingness to step into leadership roles on board of directors (President, VP, Treasurer, Secretary)
- Be knowledgeable of Banner's bylaws
- Provide general support for and oversight of the executive director
- Uphold and occasionally re-evaluate the mission of the organization
- Participate in strategic planning when necessary, and ensure the organization is upholding its current strategic plan.
